

New Rochelle United Methodist Church, a community of believers who seek to deepen their relationship with God and one another, is the product of a merger of Christ United Methodist Church (Christ UMC)--predominantly a white congregation located at 1200 North Avenue and St. Luke's United Methodist Church (St. Luke's UMC)--predominantly a black congregation located at 108 Guion Place both in the city of New Rochelle, New York.

On July 1, 2009 the Reverend Denise Smartt-Sears was appointed pastor of the two churches. Throughout the history of these two churches there had been conversations around merging. But the dialogue continued in earnest in the summer of 2009 and began to bear fruit. On June 11, 2010 during the 210th session of the New York Annual Conference and under the Resident Bishop Jeremiah J. Park, Christ UMC & St. Luke's UMC officially became the New Rochelle UMC.

A vision statement was adopted:

"A new diverse community uplifting each other with love, prayer, faith and service to transform lives through Jesus Christ"
